

## The Golf Club at Yering Meadows

The Croydon Golf Club was established in 1925 and over the years has earned the reputation of being the premier golf club in the eastern suburbs. Now located on 330 acres in the Yarra Valley, the World Class course designed by Architect Ross Watson is arguably the finest in the area. Croydon is renowned as a very friendly club and the clubhouse facilities provide the ideal surroundings for the relaxation and enjoyment of members and guests.

### Golf Course

The 27 holes provide 3 different exciting and challenging courses with fairways covered with pure Legend Couch smooth Bent Grass Greens. The course's are in excellent condition and provide a challenge for golfers of all abilities.

### Golf Competitions

The Club conducts golf competitions for Men on a Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday & Sunday; for Women on Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday; and for Men and Women on Public Holidays

### Clubhouse & Facilities

The "Lounge" and "Terrace Café" are open each day for all to enjoy the relaxing environment; We have three plasma TV's in the venue for your entertainment.

The Grove Restaurant is open Thursday through to Saturday evenings from 5:30pm onwards and Sunday lunch from 12.30pm to 3.30pm.

We also cater for functions and conferencing from as little as 6 people in The Hamilton White Room to as large as 350 people in The Vista Room.

### Golf Shop

Our Club PGA Professionals Geoff George and Michael Waghorn have an extensive range of golfing equipment and services including tuition, club cleaning & storage, and hire equipment. The Golf Shop co-ordinates the entry process and starts the field for all club competitions.

### Practice

They say "practice makes perfect" and to fine tune your game we have a number of practice facilities. There is a practice range\*, 2 large putting green's, a chipping green, a pitching green, and driving nets; all available to playing members any day, any time.

\*Practice Range is managed by the Golf Shop, golf balls can be purchased at a price of \$4 for a bucket of 40 golf balls.

### Reciprocal Golf Clubs

### House Usable Advance

The Usable Advance is a compulsory item and falls due at the time of payment of subscriptions. It has been set at \$200.00 per annum and does not include GST as GST is included in the purchases made. Once paid the Usable Advance will be added to your Membership Card/House Account and then can be used to purchase food and beverage in the clubhouse whether consumed in the clubhouse, on the course or off the premises (takeaway). The Usable Advance applies to all adult playing members over the age of 25 excluding Provisional Members. A discount applies for Family Members.

## Membership Categories & Rights

The Club offers a variety of playing or non- playing Memberships, to suit your lifestyle and budget.

### 7-Day Members (Male and Female)

Are entitled to use the Course seven days a week and to enter all major events. Currently 7 Day Membership is not available however we are accepting applications for the 7 Day Waiting List.

Conditions do apply to be placed on the waiting list .

### 6-Day Members

Are entitled to all the rights and privileges of Membership, except as follows; 6 Day members are not entitled to use the Course on Saturdays, unless playing in a mixed competition partnered by a Member entitled to play on Saturdays, or in a special competition designated 'open' by the Committee.

### Introductory Members

Introductory Membership is a value for money **playing membership** that allows you to enjoy all the rights and privileges of 6 Day Membership without the upfront entrance fee and includes access to:

- Regular weekly competitions
- 27 Hole Championship Golf Course Sunday to Friday
- World class practice facilities including short game, long game and putting greens 7 days a week

### Intermediate Members

Are persons aged 18 to 25 years who, on joining, are entitled to the same rights and privileges as 6 Day Members. Seven day playing rights are available upon written request.

### Junior / Cadet Members

Are persons aged 8 to 17 years who are entitled to the same rights and privileges as 6-Day Members. 7 day playing rights are available upon written request.

### IMPORTANT NOTE:

***An Entrance Fee is not payable for Junior Membership, however upon transferring to Intermediate Membership the Intermediate Member Entrance Fee applies..***

### Social Members

Social Members are entitled to utilise the Clubhouse facilities only.

All social and playing members will receive a member's card which will entitle them to a 10% discount on all food and beverages.

### Corporate Membership

Whether for business or pleasure Corporate Membership will be rewarding for your company and for you. Benefits include individual playing membership, 30 guest passes/company golf day, in house advertising, corporate cup participation and conference facilities.

## Membership Application

Applications for Membership should be made by correctly completing the enclosed form and returning it to the Club. For playing members the Club will promptly confirm receipt of your application and invite you to attend the next scheduled playing membership induction meeting. Playing Membership inductions take place once a month on a Wednesday Evening at 7pm or upon request. Play is only available upon payment and from the day after the membership induction meeting has been attended.

The Clubs' membership and financial year is from January to December. New members joining throughout the year are charged on a pro-rata basis for the subscription component of the new member fees. Introductory and Provisional Members are charged for the full 12 months from the date of joining. All new membership fees must be paid within 14 days of the membership induction meeting.

Please note the compulsory items for playing members, which include affiliation to the relevant state association and club personal insurance that, amongst other items, insures your golfing equipment to the value of \$3,500.
