Membership Categories Available

Ordinary members, being the normal golf playing members who have attained the age of 18 years.

Transient members, being members who intend to reside in Canberra for a maximum of three years from the time of nomination for membership. Transient members pay a loading on the annual fee in lieu of a nomination fee.

Student members, being full time students who have attained the age of 18 years and are less than 25 years, and other such applicants as approved from time to time by the Board.

Junior members, being members who have attained the age of 12 years and are less than 18 years. They have full playing rights except that no more than two juniors may play together in a competition.

Clergy members, being members who have been ordained or appointed Ministers of a recognised church or religion. They have the playing rights applicable to restricted members.

Please note the annual fees quoted are inclusive of all applicable levies and GST.

Playing Rights

Members with **Full playing rights** may play in Club competitions on any day of the week except for those competitions restricted to members of the opposite gender. They may also use the course for social play except when (a) it is being used for competition or (b) at such other times as the Board may determine.

Members with **Intermediate playing rights** may play in club competitions on any day of the week except Saturdays and for those competitions restricted to members of the opposite gender. They may also use the course for social play (other than Saturdays) except when (a) it is being used for competition or (b) at such other times as the Board may determine.

Members with **Restricted playing rights** may play in the Friday competition. They may also use the course for social play on weekdays except when (a) it is being used for competition or (b) at such other times as the Board may determine.

As a general rule, playing members have access to any of these playing rights categories. The exception is **Clergy members** who are offered a reduced annual fee which applies only to Restricted playing rights (see Structure of Annual fees). Life members have Full playing rights.

Access Sunday, members may only play in the Sunday competition, subject to paying a green fee nominated by the Board. They may also use the course for social play, subject to paying a green fee nominated by the Board on all days except Saturdays or at such other times as the Board may determine. Access members have no reciprocal or voting rights.

Payments

The club's financial year is from 1 April to 31 March.

Payments for membership are: cash, EFTPOS, Mastercard, Visa, or periodic payment agreements by the fortnight or by the month.

Nomination Fee

This is a one off fee that must accompany your membership application. The nomination fee must be paid up front in full or at the discretion of the club periodically over the club's financial year.

Annual Fees

The annual fees are pro rata until the end of the club's financial year. At the club's discretion, Transient Members may elect to have their membership subscription run for a full 12 months from their joining date.

Periodic Payments

All periodic payments run until the end of the club's financial year. A pro rata administration fee of \$65 is applicable

Course Usage

A course usage fee of \$3 for 18 holes or \$1.50 for 9 holes is applicable to all members. This fee is inclusive in competition fees and green fees.

Federal Golf Club, Membership FAQ's

Does Federal Golf Club have a waiting list for membership?

All categories of membership are currently available.

Do you have equal playing rights and access for men and women?

Federal offers equal playing rights and access for men and women across all playing categories.

Does the Club have a Student Membership category?

Yes, the club has Full Playing, Intermediate and Restricted Student Membership available. Applications for Student Membership are subject to Board approval.

Do you have a PAY TO PLAY Membership Available?

Federal has introduced a new category called Access membership. For a small annual fee and reduced joining/nomination fee, allows Sunday competition play only and social play other than competition times. Reduced green fees are charged each and every time you play and a competition fee is applicable for Sunday competition play.

Can I pay my annual subscription in instalments?

Annual fees are able to be paid via direct debit fortnightly from bank accounts or monthly from credit cards (Amex and Diners not applicable) for a small administration charge.

Can I play as soon as I submit my application with the appropriate fee?

Yes. However your application will be placed on the members notice board for a period of at least seven days. Given that there are no objections from members, your application will be forwarded to the Board for official approval. The Board reserves the right to reject any applicant to membership.

What other golf clubs are reciprocal with the club?

We have reciprocal rights with clubs in every state of Australia, many of them in the top 100 Australian courses, as well as two clubs in New Zealand and one club in Spain. Please visit our website for an up to date list of reciprocal clubs.

I don't know any members of the club. Can I still join?

Yes, we will be able to introduce you to two members of the Club who can fulfil the Proposer and Secunder portion on your nomination form.

What if I am only going to be in Canberra on a short term basis and still wish to join the Club?

Federal offers a special category of membership called Transient membership for people who will be residing in Canberra for a maximum period of up to three years. There is no joining/nomination fee for Transient Membership.

What are the key differences between membership playing categories?

Full Playing have 7 day playing rights and able to play at any time except during single (opposite) sex competitions.

Intermediate have 6 day playing rights which does not include Saturday play or during single(opposite) sex competitions.

Restricted have 5 day playing rights which does not include weekend play, Wednesday comps or during single (opposite) sex competitions.

Can I put my Membership on hold for family, travel or medical reasons?

Should any of these circumstances arise, the Club is able to offer a Non-Playing membership for a small annual fee. This category allows play of up to 6 rounds of social golf during the financial year, safeguards your joining fee and gives you the right to return to your previous playing category any time in the future. Non-Playing Members need to seek permission to play in competitions from the General Manager, Captain or President.

If I resign from the Club, am I able to rejoin without paying another joining fee?

Should you resign and wish to rejoin within three years you would be required to pay the current Non playing membership fee for the period of absence. For longer periods of absence a reduction of 10% per year of the current joining/nomination fee will apply. In the case of 10 years or more absence, no joining/nomination fee would be charged.
