TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

1. Entries to be made to: *The Tournament Secretary, The Flinders Golf Club, PO Box 11, Flinders 3929* and will only be accepted if on the official entry form, accompanied by Entry Fees and Golflink number. Entries may be attached in electronic form.
2. Entries for all events close with the Tournament Secretary on WEDNESDAY 23rd MARCH at 5pm, or as soon as fields have reached capacity, late entries will be accepted if vacancies are present in the field. Entries will not be accepted by telephone.
3. Entries for Four Ball Events must be made in pairs. The full entry fee must accompany the form – ie for both partners – and both handicaps must be shown.
4. **Requests for particular hit off times will receive sympathetic consideration but no guarantee can be given that such requests will be met.**
5. Entries are restricted to Amateurs who are members of Clubs of the Victorian Golf Association, or of Golf Clubs registered with such State or Overseas Associations as are affiliated with or recognised by this Association, and the Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
6. Entries are restricted to Amateur Ladies who are members of a W.G.A. Club and hold a current handicap. Ladies must produce Golflink cards if called upon to do so. Any reduction in handicap is automatic and comes into force immediately the score affecting it is returned (Reg. 11A (i)). Note: Ladies with temporary handicaps are not eligible to play.
7. Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Club of St. Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force at The Flinders Golf Club. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Match Committee of The Flinders Golf Club (hereinafter called the Match Committee) whose decision shall be final. Provided, however, that the Match Committee, if in doubt, shall have the right to refer any such dispute to the Council of the Victorian Golf Association and/or the W.G.V., whose decision shall then be final.
8. The Match Committee shall make all arrangements and have full power to alter the programme if necessary and make any variations in the conditions except paragraphs 5 and 6. The Match Committee reserves the right to make any alterations in the handicaps before an event is played if deemed desirable.
9. Entry into Events 5 – 9 shall be determined by handicap of the day.
10. Competitors must be prepared to play when called upon by the Match Committee and must be on the tee ten minutes before their starting time. All events will start at the 1st tee, unless otherwise determined by the Match Committee.
11. The Starter is authorised to move players forward to fill any gaps due to late arrivals. Refusal to move up will result in that player or those being moved to the end of the field. Players arriving late on the tee will also be moved to the end of the field.
12. A tie in the championship events 4 and 7 shall be decided by a sudden death play-off over Holes 1, 2, 16, 17 and 18.
13. In the event of a tie in any other event, a countback will be decided in accordance with the recommendation of the Victorian Golf Association and/or the W.G.V. in respect to such ties. Details of the system are posted in the Clubhouse.
14. Full clubhouse food & beverage service available throughout the tournament.
15. No refunds will be given for cancellations made after the draw has been completed, or for play cancelled as a result of weather conditions.
