CONDITIONS

- TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE:** The Tournament Committee shall comprise the Programmes Manager and members of the Club Match Committee. In the absence of the full committee, such members as thereof may be present at any time may give a decision and any decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Tournament Committee. The Tournament Committee shall have the sole management and control of the Tournament, with full power at any time to alter or vary any of the conditions.
- RULES:** The rules of golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and such local rules as are in force on the course over which the tournament is being played will apply. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Tournament Committee whose decision shall be final.
- PROTESTS:** The Tournament Committee's decision on matters affecting the Tournament shall be final. Protests must be made in writing and submitted to the Committee within 10 minutes of the conclusion of the days play.
- Tee-off times,** Rule 6-3a provides: "The player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee." The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However, it is a condition of this Tournament that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if the player arrives at his / her starting point ready to play, within five minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes.
A copy of the draw will be available on the GMJGF website - www.gmjgf.com on Monday, April 12.
- ENTRIES:** Entries close at 5.00 pm on Wednesday 7 April. The Tournament Committee reserves the right in special circumstances to accept late entries after April 7. Fees must be paid at the time of entry. Any entrant may withdraw and have his / her entrance fee refunded provided notification is received 7 days prior to the Tournament. The Tournament Committee has the right to refuse the entry of any person for the event without being required to give a reason for doing so.
- TROPHIES:** Trophies will be awarded in each age division dependent on the number of entries. Nett prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the Tournament Committee. Winners will be limited to one gross or one nett trophy each.
- TIES:** In the event of a tie for the gross winner of each age division a play-off will occur as decided by the Tournament Committee, until a winner is determined. Ties in Nett winners will be decided utilizing the Australian Countback system.
- PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT:** All entrants assent to be bound by the WA Golf Association's Code of Conduct. A copy of the code is available at www.wagolf.com.au/guests/memos.mhtml.
- Scorecards signed by the marker and countersigned by the player must be returned to the Tournament Office immediately on completion of each round. Breach of this condition may mean disqualification.
- ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** Tee-off times 8.00 am - 9.30 am. Presentation of trophies commencing 1.30 pm. Allocation of points for qualification for Sub-Junior Tournament of Champions is as follows:
For competing - 2 points
1st in any division additional 5 points
2nd in any division additional 3 points
3rd in any division additional 1 point
- DRESS STANDARD:** Consistent with the requirements of Wanneroo Golf Club, dress standards for the competition are to be neat casual attire with no jeans or collarless tee shirts being permitted. Shirts must be tucked into the pants and BOYS WEARING SHORTS **MUST** WEAR PREDOMINANTLY WHITE SOCKS.
- SUNSMART:** All players are to protect against the sun, wear eye protection, hats, caps, use sun screen SPF 30+ and drink ample amounts of water to avoid dehydration.
