CONDITIONS OF PLAY

ELIGIBILITY

1. Only bona fide secondary academic institutions within Western Australia that offer a general education curriculum, with entry qualifications not related to sporting achievement, shall be eligible to compete.
2. Only full-time enrolled students may represent the school.
3. All competitors must be eligible to hold an Australian passport.
4. It is essential that a teacher or official be in charge of their team.
5. Teams will comprise of two or three competitors (there are no gender restrictions) from the same secondary school.
6. **SCHOOLS MAY ENTER UP TO THREE TEAMS with the following condition.**
“ If a school enters more than one team, members of all teams must have Australian handicaps”

ENTRY FEES

An entry fee of **\$83.60 per team (inc. GST)** will be charged and must be forwarded with the entry form. Entry fee includes lunch for team members and the team official.

PLAY

The Championship will be decided by Stableford play with the best two Stableford scores to count in each team. Boys will play off the Men's tees or such other tees as the committee may decide, and girls will play off the Ladies' tees.

HANDICAP LIMIT

Handicaps must not exceed 36 for Boys and 45 for Girls

IN CASE OF TIES

In the event of a tie for any position, the Australian Count-back System will be applied using the leading two cards from each team. The winning team will become the State Champion team and will go forward to compete in the National Final in Sydney during December. Change of team members after the qualifying round will be considered in extreme emergency and only after consultation with the Organising Committee.

PERPETUAL TROPHIES FOR THE SMARTER THAN SMOKING SCHOOL TEAMS CHAMPIONSHIP

The team with the highest aggregate score will become the holder for one year of the “Western Australian School Teams Shield”. The highest aggregate score returned by a team from an Independent School will determine the holders of the “Dr G Maxwell Keys Golf Cup” for the ensuing year.

STATE FINAL TROPHIES

All members of the State Champion Team will receive commemorative prizes. The school will be awarded a permanent trophy. There will also be prizes for the runner-up team and best individual.

PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

All entrants assent to be bound by the WA Golf Association's Code of Conduct. A copy of the code is available at www.wagolf.com.au/guests/memos.mhtml.

GENERAL

1. Entry implies acceptance of the Conditions of Play governing the Championship. These conform with Royal and Ancient rules governing amateur status.
2. No practice rounds are available prior to April 30.
3. Competitors are asked to note that no caddies are allowed at any stage of the competition.
4. The Australian School Teams Championship is conducted by Golf Australia. The Western Australian qualifying round is organized by the Graham Marsh Junior Golf Foundation in conjunction with the Western Australian Golf Association and the Women's Golf WA. The organisers reserve the right to alter the Championship's conditions of play without prior notice.

EXPENSES

The winning team will have travel and accommodation expenses paid for the National Final to be held at the venue of the 2010 Australian Open Championship.

NOTE: The team winning the WA Qualifying Round of the School Teams Championship in April must be prepared to travel to Sydney for the National Final in December.

SUNSMART: All players are to protect themselves against the sun, wear eye protection, hats, caps, sun screen SPF 30+ and drink ample amounts of water to avoid dehydration.
