### Pace of Play

With the winter months upon us we now have less daylight hours for members to complete their rounds. Members are asked to increase their pace of play by:

- Walking quicker between shots.
- Be ready to play when it is your shot.
- Do not address the ball for too long. Be ready to execute your shot as soon as you are set up.
- Do not mark your card while on the green.
- Try to hole short putts, unless you will be standing on another player's line.
- Do not leave your golf bag at the front of a green; always leave it to the side nearest the next tee.
- Be ready to play at least 10 minutes before your tee-off time.

### Course Care

At this time of the year it's also important to protect high traffic and lower lying areas that can become subject to wear. Course staff will rope off problem areas if necessary, however we would like to keep that to a minimum. Players can help by being aware of and avoiding obvious "wear" areas. In addition, cart drivers are also reminded that they must follow the rules that are displayed in the carts, failure to do so could see their privileges removed from using carts in the future.
