From the Rule Book

True or false

- 1) In a Stableford competition at the par 5 2nd hole, player A gets a gross 5, net 4, for 3 Stableford points. By mistake he records a gross 5 for 4 Stableford points. The player is disqualified for recording more points than he is entitled.
- 2) A player putts from 20 feet and his ball comes to rest on the edge of the hole. The player watches his ball for some 15 seconds before walking to his ball. His ball falls into the hole 8 seconds after he arrives by the side of the hole. There is no penalty.
- 3) A ball is in a water hazard when it touches the outside edge of a stake defining the water hazard.
- 4) The position of a ball must be marked with a ball marker, a small coin or other similar object.
- 5) The line of putt is the line which the player wishes his ball to take after a stroke with his putter.
- 6) The "nearest point of relief" is the reference point for taking relief under the Unplayable Ball Rule.

Uphill and Downhill Slopes

For both uphill and downhill lies, the rule of thumb for hitting solid shots is to set your body as perpendicular to the slope as possible.

Starting with the uphill lie, think about your club selection. An upslope will produce higher flying shots than normal. If you would normally use an eight iron go back to the seven. On the upslope, set yourself perpendicular to the slope and play the ball forward in your stance. Avoid swaying down the slope on the backswing, and on the downswing force yourself to shift as much weight forward as possible.

On a downhill lie, use a more lofted club than normal, place the ball back in your stance, and keep a little more weight on your right foot to avoid swaying. To ensure you make solid contact, stay down with the shot and chase the club head down the slope.
