From the Rule Book

During a stroke round, Peter arrives at the 13th green to discover that he has left his putter at the previous green. To save time, he borrows a putter from fellow-competitor David and uses it to complete the hole.

After teeing off the 14th, a player in the group behind brings Peter’s putter over to him but questions, “How did you putt on the 13th without this?” Peter answered that he had borrowed David’s putter to which the other player replied, “I’m not sure you can do that.” What is the ruling?

A) No penalty to either Peter or David. David may recover and use his own putter.

B) Both Peter and David are penalised two strokes. David may recover and use his own putter.

C) Peter is penalised two strokes for borrowing David’s putter. David incurs no penalty but is not permitted to recover and use his putter from Peter.

D) Peter is penalised two strokes for borrowing David’s putter and must immediately declare David’s putter out of play. David incurs no penalty, may recover his putter from Peter and use it.
