Rule of the Week **Ball embedded in teeing ground**

Question: A player's tee shot strikes a tree and returns to the teeing ground, where the ball embeds in the ground. Is the player entitled to relief without penalty?

Answer: Yes. Although the Rule of Golf do not contemplate such a situation, in equity (Rule 1-4), the player is entitled to relief without penalty and must follow the procedure prescribed in Rule 25-2 for a ball that lies in a closely-mown area through the green.

The same principle would apply to other relief situations that do not contemplate relief being required within the teeing ground (e.g. Rule 24-1b)
