Competition Rules

1. ELIGIBILITY

The event is open to male and female amateur golfers with a GAWGA handicap at the date of entry.

2. MATCH COMMITTEE

2.1 The Club Match Committee will have sole management and control of the event.

2.2 In the absence of the full Match Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Match Committee.

2.3 The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the event will be final.

2.4 The decision of the Club Match Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.

3. RULES OF PLAY

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Rules Limited, will apply together with the Local Rules of the Club.

4. ENTRIES

4.1 Entrants must conform with all aspects of the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Rules Limited.

4.2 A fully completed entry form, together with the applicable entry fee must be received no later than 5:00 pm Tuesday, 6 April 2010.

5. DRAW

The draw will be available at 12:30 pm Wednesday 7 April 2010

6. THE EVENT

6.1 The event will be played over 18 holes of stroke play scored under the Stableford scoring system.

6.2 The winner of the Rockingham Glenway Open will be the competitor with the highest stableford score after 18 holes.

6.3 All ties will be decided using the Australian Count Back System.

7. TEE OFF TIMES

Rule 6-3a provides "The player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee". The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However, it is a condition of this event that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if a player arrives at their starting point, ready to play, within five minutes of their starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes in stroke play rounds.

8. MOTORISED CARTS

Motorised carts, motor scooters motor cycles and gophers are permitted on the course for the competition. Rockingham Golf Club has a limited number of golf carts for hire and an early booking through the Pro shop is essential. Contact the Pro shop on 9592 4033 for cart bookings.

9. DRESS REGULATIONS

The following dress regulations apply during the event:

On course - Neat golf attire of collared shirt and trousers or tailored shorts. Shorts must be worn with long or short predominantly white socks.

Golf Shoes - Only soft spikes may be worn on the course

Clubhouse - Golf attire and dress shoes

Please Note:

The Golf Course is an integral part of the native bushland and abounds with kangaroos, parrots and kookaburras. While the kangaroos are quite tame and tolerate the golfing fraternity well, they are still classed as wild animals.
