



Golf Cart Policy

February 2010

1. Restrictions on cart use are:

- 1.1. Members may continue to use carts, if available, on production of a medical certificate stating that they are physically unable to walk eighteen holes.
- 1.2. Members aged 75 years or more are able to use carts, if available, without a medical certificate.
- 1.3. Visitors (including member introduced guests) to the course are able to use carts only on the production of a medical certificate (one cart per two golfers with certificates). This will apply from 1 March.
- 1.4. Corporate day golfers are able to use carts only on the production of a medical certificate (one cart per two golfers with certificates).
- 1.5. No carts may be brought onto the course from outside sources unless approved by the General Manager.
- 1.6. Restrictions on corporate cart use will apply to new bookings from 1 February 2010. Existing corporate bookings for 2010 will be permitted to use carts as already agreed. Existing bookings for 2011 will be subject to these new restrictions and will be so advised.
- 1.7. Carts will continue to be banned from the course when wet.
- 1.8. Carts will be banned from the course when hot (38 deg as forecast for Adelaide Airport)
