Information regarding Cadet / Junior membership at RFGC

General information

1 Cadets – Age range 8 to 11

2 Juniors – Age range 12 to 17

3 Intermediate Juniors 18 to 20

Joining procedure

To join RFGC it is necessary to complete a single page application form

A joining nomination fee is payable upon lodgement of the application form for categories 2 & 3

The application forms are approved at Membership sub-committee meetings which are normally held the 2nd Wednesday of each month

At the end of the month the applications are formally approved at Board meetings

New member playing rights after initial nomination fees have been paid

Categories 2 & 3 are invited to play in the weekly Sunday morning Junior competitions after nomination fees have been paid

Obtaining an initial handicap

To obtain a handicap you are required to submit 3 cards as follows :

Categories 2 & 3

- 18 hole Junior competitions providing there is parental supervision for your group
- Any other time providing your 18 hole card is marked by a member over 21 years of age

Category 1

Cadets are eligible to obtain a handicap once they turn 10 and providing their development and awareness has reached a level where they are invited to join the Sunday morning Junior competitions

In the case of cadets they may submit cards for 9 holes for handicapping purposes either by playing in the Sunday morning comp or also having their card verified by a supervising parent within the 4 of the cadet or by a member over 21 at any other time

Junior development committee

Committee is chaired by Neil Cleary. Other members are Peter Carbon and fathers Chong Lim, Darryl Faulds, Darren Goss and Russell Jones

The committee meets on the 1st Wed of each month from 5:30pm to normally 7:30pm

Junior notice board

This is located just outside the main foyer and contains details of event results, upcoming events and other important messages of interest

Please ensure you check this board on a regular basis

Sunday morning competitions

Junior / selected cadets have been allocated 5 tee times commencing 8:06am

Entrance fee is \$2 and on an occasional basis there is a post game sausage sizzle – entry fee is \$3 for the sizzle days

Competitions are held most Sundays throughout the year. Details may be found in the RFGC fixture book for 2009/10

Each competition is supervised by a rostered Junior development committee person and presentations to winners etc are held on the front verandah

Open events at other Clubs – Graham Marsh Junior golf foundation

These events are held on a regular basis throughout the year predominantly during school holidays and are a mix of 18 years and under and 14 years & under

Such events are normally 18 hole and entrance fee is \$20 - \$30 including lunch in most cases

The Junior development committee is hoping to meet approx 50% of the entrance fee for selected Juniors in selected events should we succeed in meeting our sponsorship budget target

Pennants

RFGC fields a team of 7

You need to be under 18 on 1 January each year to qualify

Cadets are eligible to participate

There are 6 games of match play commencing late June and running in consecutive weeks. Games are played off handicap

Normally you need to achieve a handicap of 15 -16 and under to have a realistic chance of selection
Incidental costs are met by RFGC (uniforms, lunch , post game snacks , golf ball etc

The team manager is Danny Sheehy and the selectors are Russell Jones and Darryl Faulds with input from Committee members Peter Carbon & Neil Cleary

Cadets

Age range 8 to 11

At present there are 33 players on the books and this is considered the maximum number to ensure the training program runs smoothly

There are 4 currently on a short waiting list but there is unlikely to be any significant delay before these applications will be accepted (3 months at the most)

Annual fees are \$272 and this covers professional training programs on Wed nights from 4PM & Sunday mornings from 8:00am to 10:00am on the western practice range

Limited access to play the course under supervision is available

Juniors

General information

There is a total of 72 currently on the books – 63 males & 9 females

This number remains fairly constant over the long term and there is no waiting list

A 10 week training program is currently being conducted by the head professional for selected Juniors and Cadets

Sessions are held Saturdays 3:00pm to 4:30pm

Cost is \$150 of which the Junior development committee subsidises 50% from sponsorship funds

Fee structure

Currently fees increase on a graduated basis from age 12 to age 20

Full fees are payable once the Junior reaches 21
