Junior Golf Development Program at Royal Hobart Golf Club

Objectives of the Program

Royal Hobart Golf Club has a strong commitment to the development of junior players and is very enthusiastic about the Junior Golf Development Program.

Some of the objectives of the program are:

- ◆ Encouraging girls and boys to play golf.
- ◆ Teaching golf techniques, etiquette and developing skills.
- ◆ Fostering enjoyment of the game.
- ◆ Identifying talent and developing further skills.
- ◆ Establishing a pathway for talented/interested juniors to become members of the Club.

Clinics

Our experienced junior coaching team, Bill McPherson and Michael Bonsey, conduct junior development clinics for girls and boys (under 18 years) every Saturday at 2.00pm. These clinics are geared for all standards - particularly beginners.

The clinics focus on skill development in a relaxed and fun environment. The clinics will alternate between long and short game sessions with drills and exercises to improve swing techniques.

Junior golfers will be invited to participate in 'on-course play' once they have reached a satisfactory level of skill. During this time an understanding of etiquette, rules, course care, club and shot selection will be developed.

Golf Scholarships

As part of the Club's commitment to junior golf, each year four golfing scholarships will be awarded to selected juniors (two junior members from Royal Hobart and two junior members from affiliated Southern Tasmanian Golf Clubs).

Each scholarship holder will receive:

- ◆ Free membership to Royal Hobart Golf Club for one year.
- ◆ An advanced coaching program will be conducted by Roger Hughes, Royal Hobart's Golf Professional during the year at no cost.
- ◆ A selection of golf clothing together with other inducements.
