For 4 years I have been operating the St. Michael's Corporate Golf program, turning the operation into the success it is.

Having played on more than 2000 Golf Courses World Wide, walking through just as many Clubhouses and Pro shops and viewing the many varied ideas of how a Golf Course/ Clubhouse and Management is presented I believe I am more than qualified to lead your Corporate Event.

Having been the St. Michaels Touring Professional for over 18 years, representing the club as an Australian amateur team member and as a professional on the Australasian and Asian PGA Tours, as well as various events on the European and United States Tours, I believe is a huge asset when co coordinating and promoting your event.

With no preconceived ideas and ancient management beliefs my fresh enthusiastic love for golf and this Golf Club will guarantee you the perfect event.

With little or no advertising budget, word of mouth was the only avenue I could utilise. I continue to not need an advertising budget as the word has spread.

With the earned support of my staff, we offer a seamless operation.

I especially give gratitude to our Functions Manager Peta Goodwin and our Drinks Cart Attendant Dave Newrick, both outstanding in their separate fields and both complement our Corporate Golf no end.

I believe no one knows everything, so I pride myself that if I don't know the answer I will not only ask someone who does know, but get a second opinion.

Your Event

After the initial booking has been made, a deposit of 50% green fees will be required to confirm the date.

Over the period leading up to your event, we encourage regular communication between the company and ourselves. This is ensuring all ingredients are covered and no hiccups will occur on the day.

To make your event as easy as possible, all you have to do is invite your guests, match them up into teams and we will do the rest. Once you have sent the teams through we will allocate the shotgun starting holes, ready for your guests to just show up on the day.

St. Michael's staff will assist to any Signage, which can be displayed throughout the clubhouse and course, we usually restrict this to 1 sign every 2nd hole, but we are happy to discuss your requirements.



We encourage that you have a representative on site to welcome your guests at the registration table, hand out the score cards and any player packs you may want to give out; however, this is not a necessity.

At the registration area, a welcome LCD presentation with your company's logo and St. Michael's photographic scenery will be displayed. This is an area of opportunity to add your own presentation, which you may want to include new released items or upcoming company information to your guests.

Once the guests arrive into the St. Michael's car park, they will be greeted in the car park / golf cart allocation area by St. Michael's staff. At this point your guests with their golf clubs will be assisted into a specific golf cart tagged with your company logo and the players allocated starting hole.

At this point I personally explain where player registration is, what event they will be playing, any foods and beverages that maybe available, where your guests can warm up and any information you may also wish for us to explain.

15 minutes prior to your advertised starting time, I will announce that all players gather at the main putting green, where you can officially welcome all your guests at once, and I will cover all aspects of the day's event, local rules, handicaps and similar topics.

At this point all players will be ushered into their allocated carts and towards their allocated starting holes.

A siren will sound to start all players at once.

During the course of the round, which should take 4 hours 30 minutes to play, our drinks cart will rotate the golf course with food and beverages that you desire. Alcohol can be included; however, this must be attended to by our staff.

For the charge of \$110 for one drinks cart, we will also have another St. Michael's driven cart available at no extra charge. We would be happy for your staff to ride along.

During this period of time, whilst the players are on course, the functions room and presentation area will be set up. Your signage can be displayed as well as any special requirements.

Once your guests have finished their golf and put away their clubs. They will be ushered into the main bar area for pre presentation drinks. Showers are available, lockers and an on-site safe if needed.

During this time as players arrive back at the clubhouse score cards will be collected and calibrated if needed. A winner's result sheet will be presented if required.



Once all players are gathered in the main bar area, they can be ushered into our functions room for dining and prize presentation.

St. Michael's offers a projector and screen for any presentation your company may want to display during presentations.

At the completion of your event, signage may be available for pick up; however, on most occasions would not be available until the following day or so.
