### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Championship will be played over 36 holes of Stroke Play - 18 holes each day - Saturday, August 7 and Sunday, August 8, 2010
2. In the event of a tie or ties, play will continue over such holes as the Committee shall decide, with players being eliminated hole by hole as they fail to maintain equality with each other or others, until a winner is determined.
3. The Championship Committee comprises any or all of the WAGA Match Committee, the WAGA Executive Director, the WAGA Tournament Manager and the Host Club Match Committee. The Championship Committee reserves the right to vary any condition of the event.
4. The field will be restricted to 168 players. Should more entries be received than 168, then the highest handicapped players will be balloted out of the event.
5. Any protests must be received no later than ten (10) minutes after the completion of each round.
6. The Rules of Play will be the Rules of Golf, the Local Rules of the Host Club approved by the Championship Committee and the Uniform Sand Green Regulations.
7. **Drug Testing** - All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Drug Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, may be disqualified.
8. **Player Code of Conduct** - All entrants assent to be bound by the WA Golf Association's Code of Conduct. A copy of the code is available at [www.wagolf.com.au/guests.memos.html](http://www.wagolf.com.au/guests.memos.html).
9. **Measuring Devices** - Devices measuring distance only will be permitted during the championship.

### ENTRIES

1. The event is open to male golfers, both senior and junior who are financial members of a golf club affiliated with the Western Australian Golf Association.
2. Entries will be limited to players with handicaps of 24 and under. Entries must be signed by a club official and must be accompanied by the appropriate entry fee.
3. Entries must be lodged with the Western Australian Golf Association, P O Box 455, SOUTH PERTH WA 6951 by 5.00 pm on Wednesday, July 28, 2010.
4. a) The entry fee for the Championship is \$38.50 (including GST).  
b) Entry fee for the 4 Ball is \$30.80 (including GST) per pair and shall be held on Friday, August 6. A timesheet will be made available on Thursday, August 5 at Wagin Golf Club for players to place their names on.
5. Scrapers are provided by the club and must be used by all players.
