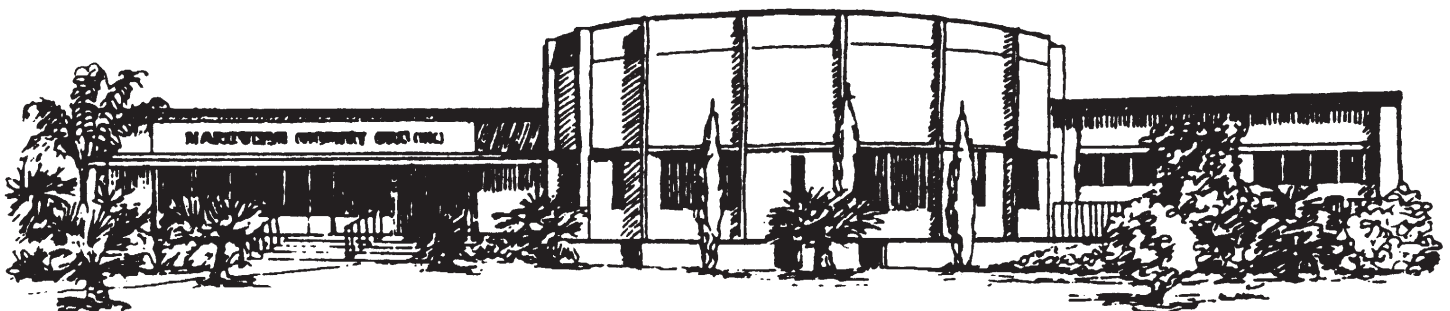

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. The Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews shall apply together with the Local Rules as drawn up by the Open Committee.
2. The Open Committee shall comprise of representatives of the Mandurah Country Club and the WA Golf Association. The Open Committee shall have the sole management of the Open with full power at any time to vary any of the conditions.
3. Eligible Players / Entries
 - 3.1 **Male amateur golfers** who are financial members **holding six and seven day category of membership at A, B & C Grade Golf Clubs** affiliated with the WA Golf Association or a club recognised by the Open Committee and whose Australian or International handicap does not exceed 18 strokes.
 - 3.2 The field will be restricted to 168 players.
 - 3.3 Should the number of entries exceed the number of places available entries for the higher handicap competitors shall be decided by ballot.
 - 3.4 Fully completed Entry Forms together with entry fees must be received by the Manager of Mandurah Country Club no later than 5.00pm on Thursday March 25th, 2010.
 - 3.5 **Entrance Fees will only be refunded in the case of a scratching being received before the closing time for entries, except for those entrants who may be balloted out and do not subsequently compete**
4. The Event
 - 4.1 The Open will be played over 72 holes of stroke play as follows:-

Round One	Saturday 3rd April, 2010	Round Two	Sunday 4th April, 2010
Round Three and Four	Monday 5th April, 2010		

After Round Two a cut will be made and the following players will proceed to the final two rounds.

 - i) The 70 lowest gross scores and ties for 70th place.
 - ii) Better nett scores will be included in the draw for the final two rounds as determined by the Open Committee.

The draw for Rounds Three and Four will be made available by 6.30pm on Sunday 4th April, 2010 by telephoning (08) 9581 2968.
 - 4.2 The Winner of the Owen Tuckey Medal will be the player with the best gross score achieved over 72 holes of stroke play. In the event of a tie for the gross winner of the Open, a sudden death play-off will take place following the conclusion of Round Four on Monday 5th April, 2010.
5. Trophies
Trophies will be awarded to gross and nett winners and other leading scores on both an overall and daily basis. **LIMIT OF ONE TROPHY PER PLAYER.**
6. Practice
All players may practice at Mandurah Country Club on the morning of Friday 2nd April, 2009 by telephoning the Professional on 9535 6488 for a tee off time. No other tee off times will be available.
7. Golf Balls
 - 7.1 It will be obligatory for all competitors in all events to play with a ball which is named in the current R&A and/or U.S.G.A. Conforming Ball Lists. Copies of these will be available at the course. Penalty: Disqualification
 - 7.2 Balls with Identical Markings to be used.
Throughout a stipulated round the ball a player uses must be of the same brand and type as detailed by a single entry in the current list of Conforming Golf Balls.
Penalty: Stroke Play - 2 strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round: 4 strokes.
8. Motorised Golf Carts
The WA Golf Association's motorised golf carts policy will apply. Copies of this are available from clubs, the Association Office or on the WAGA website. www.wagolf.com.au/guests/memos.mhtml.
9. Player Code of Conduct
All entrants assent to be bound by the WA Golf Association's Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available on the WAGA website. www.wagolf.com.au/guests/memos.mhtml
10. Drug Testing
All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Drug Agency for banned substances as laid down in the Australian Golf Union's Anti-Doping Policy.
